Len Brittain is President-Elect of the Government Finance Officers Association of the United States and Canada (GFOA), a Chicago based organization with almost 18,000 members dedicated to enhancing and promoting the professional management of governments. He will become president in June, 2010. Len is also the City of Toronto's Director of Corporate Finance, under which he manages \$4 billion in investments, \$3 billion in debt, insurance and risk management, and financial oversight of subsidiaries. He oversaw the financial analysis of major capital projects such as Metro Hall and the Green Lane landfill site and developed the City's first long term fiscal plan. Len began his career as an Economist with the Ontario government and was a founding board member of SHSC Financial Inc. which invests \$350 million of social housing capital reserves.
